

COURSE DESCRIPTION

The ACLS Provider course provides the knowledge and skills needed to evaluate and manage the first 10 minutes of an adult ventricular fibrillation/ventricular tachycardia (VF/VT) arrest. Providers are expected to learn to manage ten core ACLS cases: respiratory emergency, four types of cardiac arrest (simple VF/VT, complex VF/VT, PEA and asystole), four types of prearrest emergencies (bradycardia, stable tachycardia, unstable tachycardia and acute coronary syndromes), and stroke.
