

COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course is geared toward getting students comfortable performing in an emergency situation. The EMT-Basic is able to control life threatening bleeding, provide basic cardiac life support for a patient, as well as maintain an airway, splint an injured extremity, and administer life saving medications.

COURSE COORDINATION

This EMT-Basic course is being conducted in accordance to the National Standard Curriculum for Emergency Medical Services Education as published by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, and is approved by the Illinois Department of Public Health and the Peoria Area EMS System.

The course is being taught by Peoria Area EMS System office personnel. All instructors for this course have a minimum of 10 years experience in EMS.
