

Re: Medication Restock

Medication restock at OSF St. Francis

In order to obtain medications for restocking through the ER at St. Francis Medical Center the paramedic will need to fill out the Medication Restock sheet with the patient's name, agency name, and signature of the paramedic. The new form will more accurately track wasted controlled substances. Please fill out the amount of medication wasted and waste the medication with the RN and each person will need to sign the form.

The ER will not stock any med that is out-dated. During first shift the paramedic must go to the main pharmacy on Level G in the Main Hospital. During third shift third they have to go to the Stat Pharmacy on the 4th floor Gerlach, in the CVICU. Medications without the patient's name that need to be restocked/ replaced will have to go to the Hospital Pharmacy's as well.
