FROM THE NORTH - Take Illinois Route 159 South; you will cross the I-64 interchange at St. Clair Square. Continue on Route 159 for approximately three miles until you reach the intersection of Frank Scott Parkway and Route 159. Turn right onto Frank Scott Parkway. Continue on Frank Scott Parkway three miles to the third stoplight to the intersection of Dapron Drive and Frank Scott Parkway (note "Memorial Hospital" entrance sign). Turn left onto Dapron Drive one block and turn left onto Memorial Drive. Follow signs to the appropriate parking lot.

FROM THE SOUTH - Take Illinois Route 159 North to Illinois 15 Turn left onto ramp to Illinois 15 and continue 3.4 miles to Frank Scott Parkway West ramp. Turn left at the top of the ramp. Continue 1.9 miles on Frank Scott Parkway to Dapron Drive (note "Memorial Hospital" entrance sign). Turn right onto Dapron Drive one block and turn left onto Memorial Drive. Follow signs to the appropriate parking lot.
