Course Description

This course is being offered to current EMT-Basic and EMT Intermediate providers to increase their knowledge and skill base to the entry level Paramedic. Candidates will be able to challenge the Illinois State Paramedic Exam following successful course, clinical, and internship completion.

Course Coordination

This Paramedic Course is being conducted in accordance to the National EMS Education Standards, and is approved by the Illinois Department of Public Health and the Peoria Area EMS System.

Testing

At the completion of this course, participants can challenge the IDPH State Paramedic Exam.

Cancellation Policy

- 10 or more participants are required for this class. Class will be cancelled if less than 10 participants are registered.
- Class size is limited to maximum of 25 students.
- Non-attendance will result in forfeiting the course fee. Non-attendance includes cancellation with less than 24 hours notice.
- The EMS Course Coordinator and the EMS System Coordinator have the ability to make exceptions to the cancellation policy.

Requirements

Written verification of one year work experience as an EMT-Basic or EMT-Intermediate, Current/Valid Healthcare Provider CPR Card, No felony convictions, Meeting/Interview with The PAEMS Medical Director, Adheres to the PAEMS 2016 Student Handbook. Health Information as required below.

Health Information

You must submit proof of a recent physical examination (within one year), as well as tuberculosis (TB) testing and certain immunizations before you will be allowed into the course. Immunizations and physical exam can be obtained at a healthcare provider of your choice or from OSF Occupational Health. **Note – you may have already had many or all of the required immunizations and or examinations from regular visits to your doctor, or if they are required by your employer or the military. (The cost of this is not included in the course fee).**

Deadline: Registration form and payment due 14 days prior to start of class.
