### Paul Ciolino Biography

Paul Ciolino is a lifelong resident of Chicago and was the first and only Homicide Investigation expert hired by 48 Hours and CBS News as an on air personality and expert. He has appeared in hundreds of news program on every major cable and television network in both the United States and Canada. His shows on CBS's 48 Hours averaged 6.5 million viewers per episode.

He also sits on the board of The International Association of Forensic Criminologists (IAFC) He is the past president of The National Association of Legal Investigators, past president of The Special Agents Association, and former multi term board member of The Council of International Investigators. He is a former winner of The International Investigator of the year award and The Louisiana investigator of the year.

Ciolino has authored or co-authored five books. His most recent book is:

*Dead In Six Minutes*, The Biography of Dr. Stanley M. Zydlo Jr. MD, and the creation of the Paramedic profession. Published by Forensic Press, Sitka, AK, December 2016.
